1 This cause came before the Court upon Plaintiff Karl Beck’s (“Plaintiff”) Motion to Compel  
2 Requests for Production (Set One) to all Defendants (the “Motion”). The Court, having reviewed the  
3 submissions and heard oral argument on Plaintiff’s Motion, and upon finding good cause, hereby  
4 GRANTS Plaintiff’s Motion as follows:

5 (1) Defendant Point Loma Patients Consumer Cooperative Corporation (the “PLPCC”) is  
6 ordered to respond to Requests two (2) through seven (7) from Plaintiff’s Requests for Production  
7 (Set One), as amended through meet and confer, within 14 days from entry of this Order.

8 (2) Defendants Adam Knopf and Justus H. Henkes IV are ordered to respond to Requests  
9 one (1) through seven (7), and nine (9) through ten (10) from Plaintiff’s Requests for Production (Set  
10 One), as amended through meet and confer, within 14 days from entry of this Order.

11 (3) Defendants 419 Consulting, Inc., Golden State Greens LLC, Far West Management,  
12 LLC, Far West Operating, LLC, and Far West Staffing, LLC are ordered to respond to Requests one  
13 (1) through seven (7), and nine (9) through eleven (11) from Plaintiff’s Requests for Production (Set  
14 One), as amended through meet and confer, within 14 days from entry of this Order.

15 (4) Defendants are further ordered to produce all documents and electronic data  
16 responsive to the above Requests within 14 days after service of further responses.
