

Critical Points About Dr. Mark Cooper in the Biker Sherlock Case

1. According an article from [ESPN](#), within two or three days after Biker's death, Dr. Mark Cooper spoke with the Sherlock family. He concluded that Biker suffered from CTE, even without examining him.
2. Biker's widow, Amy, later discovered that Dr. Cooper, was a child psychologist with no known specialty in neurology or CTE. No published papers about CTE can be found with his name on them.
3. Note that CTE can ONLY be diagnosed with a brain autopsy.
4. Amy sought to donate Biker's brain for CTE research, but the coroner informed her that Biker did not have CTE.
5. Dr. Cooper received 8 Driving Under the Influence (DUI) arrests over a two-year period. His Blood Alcohol Concentration (BAC) levels during the DUI incidents, range from 0.169 percent to an alarming 0.48 percent.
6. In June of 2022, Dr. Cooper surrendered without any opposition his Psychologist License (No. 14723) based on a Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order.
7. Dr. Cooper died on September 7, 2022. The cause of death was not published.

12. Lake told me that Dr. Cooper is a friend and professional colleague of his.
13. I later discovered that Dr. Cooper is a child psychologist with no known specialty in neurology or CTE.
14. Subsequently, I called the called the coroner about Biker and sought to have his brain donated for CTE research.
15. The coroner told me that Biker did not have CTE.
