On November 2, 2022, at 8:30 a.m., in Department C-75 of the above-entitled Court located at 330 West Broadway, San Diego, CA 92101, the *Ex Parte* Application for an Order Dismissing the First Cause of Action for Violation of the Cartwright Act (“Application”) as to Defendant STEPHEN LAKE (“LAKE”) came on regularly for hearing, with Honorable James A.
