
PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on November 2, 2022 at 8:30 a.m., in Department C-75 of the County of San Diego Superior Court, Central Division, located at 330 West Broadway, San Diego, CA 92101, Defendant STEPHEN LAKE (“Defendant” or “LAKE”) brought an *ex parte* application to dismiss Plaintiffs AMY SHERLOCK, an individual and on behalf of her minor children, T.S. and S.S., ANDREW FLORES (collectively “Plaintiffs”) first cause of action for violation of the Cartwright Act as a result of Plaintiffs’ failure to amend their First Amended Complaint (“FAC”) as ordered by the Court on August 19, 2022. The Court, hereby orders as follows:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

1. Plaintiffs’ First Cause of Action for Violation of the Cartwright Act is hereby dismissed with prejudice as to LAKE.
2. LAKE is the prevailing party as to Plaintiffs’ First Cause of Action for Violation of the Cartwright Act.
3. LAKE is entitled to an award of costs.
