1 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between plaintiff Karl Beck, by and through his
2 attorney of record William Restis, and defendants Point Loma Patients Consumer Cooperative
3 Corporation, Adam Knopf, Justus H. Henkes IV, 419 Consulting Inc., Golden State Greens, LLC,
4 Far West Management, LLC, and Far West Operating, LLC, Far West Staffing, LLC, by and
5 through their attorneys of record Tamara M. Leetham and Matthew Dart, as follows, subject to
6 the Court's approval:

7 1. On May 17, 2018, Plaintiff and Defendants attended voluntary mediation with the
8 honorable Joel Pressman (retired). The case did not settle but the parties agreed to return for a
9 second time in a renewed effort to settle.

10 2. On July 30, 2018, Plaintiff and Defendants attended a second day of voluntary
11 mediation with Judge Pressman. During the mediation, the parties arrived at settlement terms and
12 signed a class settlement term sheet.

13 3. To allow for the settlement process to proceed without the parties having to incur
14 additional expenses, and to preserve the trial court's resources, the parties request that the trial
15 date set for March 1, 2019 and all discovery, motions, motion cut-off dates, and other trial related
16 dates and deadlines be vacated.

17 4. The parties intend to submit the class settlement for preliminary approval at the
18 earliest available date. In the event the Court feels it appropriate, the parties are agreeable to
19 setting a status conference in 90 days.
